Rescue Village provides a meaningful way for individuals, families, businesses, organizations, schools and groups to help meet the needs of homeless animals in Northeast Ohio. RV also offers fundraising opportunities through our events. Funds from events like those listed below can also be allocated for credit towards specific fundraising events per RV discretion.

FUNDRAISE \$1,000 IN A WEEK

Support RV homeless animals by using one of the options to fundraise as little as \$1,000 in a week! Use both to double your donation to animals in need.

Option 1: Six Steps to \$1,000

- 1. Donate to yourself. It starts with you! \$50
- 2. Ask 4 family members to donate \$50/each \$200
- 3. Ask 14 family members and friends to donate \$25/each \$350
- 4. Ask 10 co-workers to donate \$25/each \$250
- 5. Ask 6 neighbors to donate \$15/each \$90
- 6. Ask 1 local business to contribute \$60 \$60

Option 2: Four Steps to \$1,000

- 1. Ask 5 local businesses to donate \$50/each! \$250
- 2. Ask 5 members of an organization you belong to for \$10/each \$50
- 3. Host a community fundraising event! Sell goods or services and put proceeds towards a donation to RV. \$200
- 4. Share your link on FB, Instagram, and more to send it to 25 friends asking for \$25/each \$500

Inspire Support

Crafting Your Ask to Donors

Using the facts and questions below, craft your direct ask. An ask would start with a fact or statistic about Rescue Village, followed by a call to action urging for support or a specific donation amount, and ending with a direct link to your fundraising page URL.

Use a combination of a RV fact/stat followed by a call to action calling the donor to action on social media, through emails, and text messages to potential supporters.

Rescue Village Facts & Stats

- Rescue Village is a 501(c)(3) non-profit addressing animal homelessness through same-day, barrier-free adoptions, humane investigations, shelter programs, spay and neuter, and community engagement initiatives.
- RV houses up to 140 cats, dogs, kittens, puppies, small animals, and barn animals!
- RV serves over 3,000 animals, providing over \$1 Million on medical care each year to animals in northeast Ohio.
- RV's shelter veterinary clinic performs over 4,000 shelter surgeries each year.
- Rescue Village hosts Ohio's most prominent, public, outdoor dog festival and fundraiser, Woofstock. In 2024, the event welcomed 9,800+ attendees and reached nearly 3 million through social media efforts.
- RV welcomes over 100 tour and service groups each year.
- RV hosts summer camp for over 150 campers each summer.
- 60% of homeless animals at Rescue Village arrive as owner surrenders or stray cats, or through one of RV's 50+ transfer partners.
- Rescue Village is a No-Kill shelter, releasing 98% of homeless animals annually.

Getting Started

Hosting an Independent Fundraising Event



1 Notify RV about your fundraising event

After choosing your fundraising event, please notify Rescue Village about your event. This allows us to track and thank our community supporters effectively. Supporters can complete the online form on our website: www.rescuevillage.org/get-involved/hostacomunityevent.

On the form, you can request to have a Rescue Village staff member, and ambassador therapy dog when applicable onsite at your event! From there you will be contacted directly by Rescue Village. You may also choose to complete the form at the end of your event.

2 Receive your thank you letter from RV

Rescue Village will respond to your request with logistics for your event or donation drop-off for past events. This will include a thank you letter that can be sent to donors.

If Rescue Village is unable to assist with your event or if an event does not align with our mission, you will hear directly from Rescue Village.

Examples of unauthorized events include but are not limited to:

- Community Events that are inconsistent with RV's mission and goals.
- Political events endorsing politicians.
- Events that conflict with RV campaigns and initiatives.
- Community Events ask RV to sell tickets and items or solicit them.

Rescue Village is happy to attend and support fundraisers aligned with our lifesaving mission.





Planning Steps for your Event



3 Create your plan and build your team

Determine what you will need to do to make the event successful. Will you be holding this event yourself, or will people be helping? You want people on your team who are as passionate about animal welfare as you are to achieve success in your event.

Determine when meetings will be held and set deadlines. This will keep everyone on track and goal-oriented. Together, decide on your budget, how much you can spend, and how much you hope to raise in donations. This will drive your budget.

4 Choose your fundraising event & notify RV

Get creative! Maybe tie a fundraising component into an event that is already in the works or suggest something completely new! Feeling stuck? See our suggested event types. Make sure your event is something your team members are excited about, and everyone agrees on the focus and goal.

After choosing your event, Complete the Host a Community Event Form on our website: www.rescuevillage.org/get-involved/hostacomunityevent. to receive support from our team.

5 Receive your custom materials

Upon approval, Rescue Village will email you your thank you letter, a flyer, and fundraising page to send donors for support. On your event form, please include all photos, logos, and information you would like included.

Spread the word about your event

Tell the community about your event! Share it on social media and send your friends and family directly to your fundraising page. Don't forget- be sure to tag @TheRescueVillage on Facebook and @rescuevillage on Instagram.

Collect donations and host your event

If you can collect donations ahead of time, your fundraising page will accept them from the moment it is created until the end of your event. This is the easiest way to collect credit card donations. If you are collecting cash or checks, be sure to keep them in a secure and safe location for when you drop them at Rescue Village. To raise money, you may ask for donations, create a registration fee, or sell a good or service. Take photos of your event or team to share with RV! After your event share your photos to events@rescuevillage.org.

Thank donors and submit donations to RV

Once the event has ended, thank your team and planning committing and send out thank you emails and letters. Thank participants and sponsors, informing them of the impact made. See the thank you letter template and email template. You may also request a donation hand-off at Rescue Village by notifying gbsesmer@rescuevillage.org.
